- Continue to implement Daily Rapid Reading across Years 3 & 5 semester one and Years 2 & 4 semester two.
- Implementation of Building Blocks for Learning Literacy Program from Prep to year six
- Implement Comprehension strategies across years three to six
- Develop and implement evidenced based spelling program with the support from Dr Christensen.
- Develop and implement coding across P-Year 6 classes
- Purchase coding equipment and professional development resources.
