- Achieve above NMS - National Minimum Standards in reading and spelling for their year level or have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.
- Develop an evidenced based inclusive literacy program linked to the Australian Curriculum.
- Advance STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics).
- Increase the number of students receiving a C or better on their report card.
- Release teachers for pre and post moderation each term.

Our initiatives include

- Employment of teacher aides to support teachers in the implementation of the Australian Curriculum.
- Employment of teacher aides to focus on our Early Years Literacy Program.
- Development and implementation of an evidenced based literacy program focused on teachers pedagogy within the classroom, with the support from Dr Christensen.
- Development and implementation of coding across Prep-Year 6 classes.
- Purchase of coding equipment and professional development resources.
- Creation and provision of support for professional learning around alternate "literacies" and intentional communication including signing, picture symbols and assistive technologies.
- Release of teachers for pre and post moderation of the C2C units.
