COMMUNITY NEWS

Outside School Hours Care (OSHC):

The Parents and Citizens Association run an Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) service. Hours of operation are 6am to 8:30am for Before School Care (BSC) and 3pm to 6pm for After School Care (ASC); school days only. **YOU MUST BOOK YOUR TIMES**. A text to their mobile (0458 759 776) is sufficient or speak to someone at the service. Whilst we offer from 6am, you must make the service aware otherwise an educator will be there from 6:30am.

We do not offer vacation care.

The service does not offer catering. Parents can provide breakfast or afternoon tea if required. We will supervise children eating separately to the work area. We are mindful of special dietary needs of all.

Bookings are essential. Enrolment forms must be completed prior to attendance. Costs are \$20 BSC and \$23 ASC per child <u>BEFORE</u> the Child Care Subsidy is applied. All children must be signed in for BSC and signed out when collecting them from ASC. Staff will sign out children after the morning session and in for the afternoon.
